New EBA Prayer Team by Tim Shull

When it is all said and done concerning prayer, there is more said than done. Do you pray, or do you just talk about prayer? Does your church have an active prayer ministry? Do you make your plan and your daily to-do list and then ask God to bless it, or do you go to our God first? Do you stress and worry over your needs and the needs of your church, or do you first "take it to the Lord in prayer"? Do you get deep into problem solving and project management without first consulting our Heavenly Father? Do you follow the last resort mantra: "When all else fails, pray." Or is prayer your first resort?

We need a renewed commitment to pray for one another, pray for our churches, pray for our pastors, pray for our Acts 1:8 witness, pray for the lost, and pray for our nation. When we look at the ever-increasing speed with which our country and our society are degrading into deeper and deeper depravity, we must consistently, regularly, and fervently pray.
