CCC 2023 by Tim Shull


Churches Changing Communities, CCC, has been a marvelous vehicle for ministry for the churches of Edgefield Baptist Association since 2010. Hundreds of local mission projects have been completed in Jesus' name and lives have been changed for the better. During the pandemic we couldn't have it like we were used to, so we found other, sometimes better, ways to minister to people in our communities. In 2022, we held a CCC week again, seeking to overcome our loss of momentum. It was a great week, enjoyed by all who participated. We found last year and this year that the new school summer schedule affects many youth and families who might otherwise join us. The number of summer weeks out of school is a smaller number now and many summer activities and opportunities compete and win out over CCC. I understand. Staying in your home area, sleeping on the floor, working hard in the hot sun is a tough choice when compared to a week of beach or vacation or camp. Band, cheerleading, football, and other teams start earlier now as well.

Yet still we have 44 adults and youth signed up for CCC this year (36 construction, 8 ministry/prayer) (11 youth, 33 adults). Our construction/repair teams will help in 10 projects and our ministry/prayer team will conduct many visits/projects of prayer and kindness. While we will not have youth dorms at the church this year, we will enjoy breakfast fellowship each morning, lunch at the work sites, and a wonderful wind-down fellowship supper each evening. We will gather for inspiring worship after supper on Sunday night and on Thursday night.

CCC 2023 will be a wonderful time of intergenerational, interchurch and interracial fellowship and ministry. Grateful homeowners will greatly appreciate the help on much needed repairs. Senior adults will appreciate the visits, games, and love, as will the children in the backyard Bible fun times and others in the various ministry sites. At each site of service, we will make sure that folks know that we are sharing the love of Jesus and we'll be ready to tell how Christ changed our lives and how our churches stand ready to help and receive them.

We are grateful for each church and each person who helps CCC 2023 in any way. Much thanks to Edgefield First Baptist Church for hosting us and we are thankful for each church that brings and serves a meal. We appreciate our camp pastor Joshua Rushing; our meals coordinator Barbara Langley; our camp nurse Jenny Banner; our team leaders Bubba Wells, Fisher Miller, Bud Parker, Wayne Miller, Rusty Bethune, and Susan Keck; our administrator Faye Usry; and our worship team from Edgefield First Baptist Church.
