## **Ebenezer and Parksville welcome Interim Pastors**



Ebenezer Baptist called Rev. Danny Hedgepeth as Interim Pastor on September 30, 2023. He has served thirty-two years as a full-time pastor of Southern Baptist churches and ten years as a transitional interim pastor at five churches. Rev. Hedgepeth has authored thirty-four articles since 2016 that have been featured in *Mature Living*, *Open Windows*, and *Deacon*.

He and his wife of forty-seven years, Sherry, moved back home to North Augusta in February 2023 with the intent and call to continue serving as an interim and transitional pastor. They have one daughter, Sarah, who is married to Hagan Lee.



Parksville Baptist named Rev. Charles Drummond as Interim Pastor on January 14<sup>th</sup>. Rev. Drummond served as a Georgia Baptist State Missionary for the Georgia Baptist Mission Board from 2005 -2020. He has been active in leadership roles in the Georgia Baptist Mission Board, serving as an Executive Committee member and a Vice President.

He is a 6 E- Evangelism and Church Revitalization Facilitator and led seven Pastor Roundtables for Church Revitalization. Being a trained Intentional Interim Pastor and Transitional Interim Pastor, he has served as Interim Pastor for 13 Churches since 2005.

Rev. Drummond began his pastoral ministry in 1973 and served four churches over 32 years in Georgia and Tennessee. Prior to his pastoral ministry he served in the United State Marine Corps.

He and his wife, Lawana, have been married for 52 years and reside in Evans, GA.

# 2024 Big Stevens Creek Ichmul Mission Trip









A team of fifteen spent six days in Ichmul Mexico January 3-9. Ichmul is a small village located four hours southwest of Cancun. The team worked in conjunction with Mission House Partners International. The team consisted of a Medical Team, a Home Visitation Team, and a Children's Ministry Team.

The Medical Team saw approximately 100 patients in three different villages. They also performed wellness checks in the High School and Middle School.

The Children's team did VBS in three villages ministering to over 200 children. They also distributed clothes and salvation dolls.

The Home Visitation Team had numerous evangelistic contacts distributing materials and Bibles. Three of the residents in Ichmul gave their lives to Christ.
