Since then, our volunteers have delivered over 250 beds (with new sheets, pillow, and children's Bible) to children suffering from sleep deprivation due to sleeping on inflatable mattresses, beds with multiple siblings, broken beds, or even on the floor. After setting up the new bed, we prayed with each family. Tears

were frequently shed from the joy that their lives are so radically improved. This ministry allows us to take God's word into homes that need to hear of our Creator.

"Truth Has a Name" by Tim Shull

We live in a time and culture that is characterized by heaping promulgations of falsehood. Whether it is from entertainment culture, the news media, the political arena, the social media platforms, big tech, or from demonstrations in the streets, we are subjected to a barrage of declarations that we know are not truthful. The strategy of the "god of this age" (2 Cor. 4:4) seems to be to have his willing workers repeat lies loudly and as often as possible. "Repeat a lie often enough and it becomes the truth", is a law of propaganda often attributed to the Nazi Joseph Goebbels. I started to make a list of modern lies that are generally believed, but the list takes much more space than I have here. Even science, that formerly used the scientific method in an objective pursuit of the truth, has morphed into huge donor-funded consensus-building and silencing of objection and peer review.

In our day we most certainly fulfill the Bible prophecy, "For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables." 2 Timothy 4:3-4. We also lie to ourselves. We often hear the Disney movie guidance, "follow your heart" or "your heart always knows best" or "trust your feelings". No! This is incredibly bad advice! Feelings and emotions lie to us all the time. Long ago the Bible warned, "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked; who can know it?" Jeremiah 17:9-10. Our hearts will lead us astray and even to destruction. "There is a way that seems right to man, but in the end, it leads to destruction." Proverbs 14:12.

"The heart wants what it wants" is an expression used by spoiled Americans to justify decisions based upon selfish and self-centered emotionalism. Oprah Winfrey popularized the notion that every person can have their own truth. "You have your truth and I have mine. That may be your truth, but I have a different truth." Ridiculous! Truth is objective and God's objective truth is absolute. Winston Churchill wrote, "Truth is inconvertible. Malice may attack it and ignorance may deride it, but, in the end, there it is." Ben Shapiro often says, "Facts don't care about your feelings."

As believers in and followers of Jesus Christ, we must recognize that we are in spiritual warfare and that "truth is the first casualty of war". We have the Word of God to guide us. "Your word, Lord, is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path." Psalm 119:105. "All scripture is inspired by God and is profitable for teaching, for rebuking, for correcting, for training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work." 2 Timothy 3:16-17. "For the Word of God is living and effective and sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating as far as to divide soul, spirit, joints, and marrow; it is the judge of the ideas and thoughts of the heart." Hebrews 4:12.

And the written word always leads to the Living Word. "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God...And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth." John 1:1&14. Grace without truth may decay into liberalism. Truth without grace may evolve into legalism. Christ was full of both grace and truth. "And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He explained to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself." Luke 24:27. Jesus said, "You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." John 8:32. Pay attention. It is knowing the Truth that makes us free. We must know Him and not just know about Him. Truth has a name. He is Jesus Christ, the Messiah and Son of the living God. "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." John 14:6. We must know the Truth, stand up for the Truth, speak the Truth, publish the Truth, share the Truth, live the Truth, and proclaim the Truth until He comes again.
