#### Choose Life by Tim Shull

The incredible Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision of January 1973 flew in the face of 4,000 years of Western civilization. It violated the fundamental tenets of America's Judeo-Christian heritage and the U.S. Declaration of Independence. Roe ignored the many laws on the books that consider a baby in the womb to be a person. Roe contradicted the Hippocratic Oath that guided the medical profession for centuries. The ruling also violated the 5<sup>th</sup> and the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendments to the United States Constitution. The 5<sup>th</sup> Amendment declares no person shall "be deprived of life, liberty, or property without due process of law." The 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment sets forth: "Nor shall any State deprive any person of **life.** liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws." The majority seven justices in 1973 got around this Constitutional prohibition by declaring a baby in the womb to be a non-person. just as the Court ruled in 1856 in the notorious Dred Scott decision that Negroes were nonpersons. Roe v. Wade is the Dred Scott Decision of our lifetime, and even worse. 63 million innocent babies were put to death. The denial of personhood has been a historic rationalization for atrocities: We said the African wasn't a human person, so we deprived him of Liberty. We said the American Indian wasn't a human person, so we deprived him of Property. We say the person growing in the womb isn't a human person, so we deprive her of Life. Life, Liberty and Property denied because the victim was/is deemed not to be a human person. Hitler's Nazi holocaust against Jews used the same "non-person" rationale. Abortion is the American Holocaust. In all the wars the United States has fought since the Revolutionary War, the number of Americans killed totals 1,354,675. We kill more preborn babies than that every year in America.

Declare it clearly: The baby growing in the womb is most certainly a human person, as all expectant parents well know. With modern ultrasound, it could not be clearer. It's a precious baby! a boy or a girl! not a blob of tissue! Anyone can see this. Help Crisis Pregnancy Centers afford HD Ultrasound. When a young woman or girl can see the baby within her, her heart melts with love and she is willing to receive the help that is offered to her. In the first trimester, preborn babies have beating hearts, can suck and swallow, have unique fingerprints, develop right or left-hand dominance, possess unique DNA, react to touch, and have detectable brainwaves. There can be no doubt: It's a baby! She sucks her fingers, has her own ABO blood type, and can most certainly feel pain.

**The Word of God:** The Bible clearly conveys to us God's view of the human person growing in his/her mother's womb. To Jeremiah He said, "*I knew you before I formed you in your mother's womb. Before you were born I set you apart and appointed you as my prophet to the nations.*" Jeremiah 1:5. David worships our creator and how He made each one of us. "*You created my inmost being; You knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Your works are wonderful; I know that full well. My frame was not hidden from You when I was made in the secret place..." Psalm 139:13-15. Paul writes in Galatians 1:15 "It pleased God to sanctify me in my mother's womb and call me through His grace, to reveal His Son in me, that I might* 

preach Him among the gentiles." Consider the marvelous occasion when Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth, several months pregnant with John the Baptist. When the good news of the Messiah's coming was declared, the Bible says: "The babe leaped in her womb..." Luke 1:41,44. Luke further declares that John was "filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb" Luke 1:15. The Holy Ghost fills people, not tissue or cells. The New Testament Greek word for baby is ( $\beta \rho \epsilon \phi o_{\zeta}$ ) brephos. It is the same word used here in this passage for the unborn baby in Elizabeth's womb. The Thayer Greek Lexicon defines brephos as "embryo, fetus, newborn child, young child or nursing child." This same word is used to describe Jesus in the manger (Luke 2:16) and Timothy as a "child" learning the scriptures. 2 Timothy 3:15. There is simply no doubt that the Bible teaches the personhood of the baby in the womb. The Bible says that we are to "choose life" Deuteronomy 30:19. The abortionists choose death. The politicians who advocate for abortion on demand choose death. The citizens who vote for them choose death. I call on you today to choose life.

Yes, **celebrate and thank God**; it's been a long 49 ½ years with much work and prayer. Thank God for our SC legislators, Attorney General and Governor. Know that last Friday's Supreme Court decision nullifying Roe will not change human hearts. We need revival. Pray for a Great Awakening. Teach, Encourage, Support, Minister, Redeem. We must faithfully teach Biblical and responsible sexuality and proclaim the sanctity of human life from conception to natural death. Boys must be taught respect for girls and appropriate conduct. It is the irresponsible sexual conduct of boys/men that causes the crisis pregnancy. If men had sex only with their wife, whom they love, nurture and support, the decreased demand for abortion would put the supply side out of business. We must generously support Crisis Pregnancy Centers and promote adoption. We must be accepting and helpful and gentle to those who face an unplanned pregnancy and minister redemptively to all. Preach and share the Gospel: When you confess your sin and repent, God forgives, no matter who you are or what you've done. Rejoice in the promise that *"there is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.*" Romans 8:1. Choose the abundant life and eternal life that comes only through Christ Jesus.
