

"It Will Never Happen Here" – compiled by Tim Shull

NASHVILLE (BP) -- Southern Baptists should not seek first to defend themselves in response to recent sexual abuse reports but should hold offending churches accountable, SBC President J.D. Greear told the SBC Executive Committee on February 18. In his report to the committee, Greear presented 10 calls to action based on initial recommendations from the Sexual Abuse Presidential Advisory Study he initiated last year. The recommendations include a request that the Executive Committee begin the process to amend the SBC's governing documents to define the mishandling of abuse as a basis for disfellowshipping a church, as well as the disclosure that the advisory study is continuing to consider the possibility of a database for offenders.

Greear's report followed an investigative series the previous week by the Houston Chronicle, joined by the San Antonio Express-News, that found 220 pastors and other leaders in Southern Baptist churches who had been convicted of or taken plea deals in sex crimes involving more than 700 victims.

Members of the SBC Executive Committee bylaws workgroup got to work immediately and have released a thoughtful and measured statement responding to President Greear's challenge. It is worth reading, so I have included the link below.
