Worship is Not Optional by Tim Shull

Whether it be corporate or family or private, whether it be online or inperson, whether it be outdoors or indoors, whether it be physically distanced or close gatherings, now more than ever, **we need worship.** Plus, our Sovereign Lord deserves our adoration and devotion. *"Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come!"* Revelation 4:8. *"Oh come, let us worship and bow down; Let us kneel before the Lord, our Maker."* Psalm 95:6.

Worship delights our Father, develops our Family, declares our Faith, defeats our Foe, and dethrones our Flesh. Worship is placing my mind's attention and my heart's affection on the Lord in response to who He is and what He has done. When we worship, God's presence is experienced, God's pardon is offered, God's purposes are revealed, God's power is displayed. In Isaiah 6:1-8, we see that When I worship...

1. I See God for who He is. He is High and He is Holy.

"In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple. Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. And one cried to another and said: 'Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory!" Isaiah 6:1-3. "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways,' says the Lord. 'For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts." Isaiah 55:8-9. "Oh, worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness! Tremble before Him, all the earth." Psalm 96:9

2. I See Myself for who I am. I need Confessing and Cleansing.

"And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke. So I said: 'Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts." Isaiah 6:4-5. "Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal which he had taken with the tongs from the altar.
