CCC 2022

We are looking forward to having our classic CCC again. As we work together to do deeds of kindness and share words of witness, lives will be blessed, and the name of our Lord will be exalted. Churches in Edgefield Baptist Association had conducted Churches Changing Communities for ten years before we had to take a break, mainly for reasons associated with the pandemic.

CCC 2022 will be July 10-14 and hosted by Edgefield First Baptist Church. Rev. Aaron Tripp will be our Camp Pastor. Some things will remain the same. Some things this year will be different.

Same:

- We need for our churches to help us identify homeowners who need a repair or help with yardwork. We'd rather have the projects come from our churches so that follow-up is more likely to continue as part of the church's ongoing ministry.
- We will have construction team leaders who will assess the requested projects, order materials and plan for the work.
- > We need some adults willing to lead some ministry/prayer projects in our local area.
- > Registrants will get a great T-shirt and help pay for CCC costs with their registration fee.
- We will enjoy some marvelous times of intergenerational, interchurch, interracial ministry, fellowship, meals, worship and growth.
- > Youth will have swim night on Wednesday evening and other fun stuff on the other nights.
- We need a Church Coordinator for each church. This Coordinator will start promoting the dates now, will soon get the registration packet, then will help youth and adults in that church to get registered by June 14.

Different: What's new in 22?

- Four Days of Work instead of five. We will organize, eat and worship together Sunday evening. The workdays Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday will start with breakfast at EFBC, have lunch on site; then an evening supper fellowship. Pastor Aaron will bring a lesson for all ages: Monday and Tuesday at the supper tables, Wednesday at the pool, and Sunday & Thursday in the EFBC Sanctuary. Our opening worship Sunday night and closing worship on Thursday night will include inspiring music. We'll have a time of fun and fellowship each evening and then go home. Friday will be available for finishing projects that need more work/time.
- We will not have a dormitory for students at the host church. We invite students and adults this year to come and go, using the host church as base for meals, organizing/sending volunteers, and worship. Some youth families may want to organize sleepovers at their homes and carpools to and from EFBC.
- > This year the registration fee for the week is \$80, which is down from previous years.

We will be working on all the preparation for CCC in May and June. A registration packet will soon be given to each Church Coordinator so he/she can promote, get youth and adults registered, and turn in the registration to EBA on June 13-14. Save the dates, start promoting, and plan to join in the fun.

I hope you can come to the Heart4Schools training on May 10 at EBA. 10:30 am with lunch provided. No church is too small to find ways to minister in and through our schools. Call the EBA office to let us know you're coming.

Pastors and teachers, we have a great opportunity before us as we are being invited into the federal prison to preach and teach the gospel. Come to the meeting with the federal prison chaplain on May 17 at 7 pm at the EBA office.

Come help us hand deliver the health ministry packets at the migrant worker camps on May 19, meeting at EBA at 6 pm.
